

SECTION 4 – PHYSICAL HAZARDS

1. Acute Overexposure: Causes eye and skin irritation. May cause respiratory irritation.
2. Chronic Overexposure: Prolonged or repeated frequent contact with skin by removing natural oils may cause dermatitis.

EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES

1. INHALATION: Remove from over-exposure to fresh air. If breathing is difficult or discomfort occurs, obtain medical attention.

3. SKIN: Wash with running water until skin is free from soapiness. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If irritation persists, get medical attention.
4. INGESTION: Drink 1 to 2 glasses of water or milk. DO NOT induce vomiting. Get immediate medical attention.
